

Submitting Your Consumer Confidence Report (CCR)

It's time to get your data ready to complete your annual CCR. Community public water systems are required to communicate any and all data and violations each year in a CCR in line with the CCR Rule. These reports provide public water system consumers information about their local drinking water quality.

Following are important due dates to remember:

- **April 1** – Wholesale systems to provide a CCR to consecutive systems
- **July 1** – CCRs are to be completed, distributed to customers, and submitted to your regulatory agency
- **October 1** – CCR certificates (or waivers) of distribution are due to your regulatory agency.



Keep in Mind!

ADEQ can provide a free review to help ensure your report is complete. Simply send in a draft of your CCR to CCRRule@azdeq.gov and a Compliance Assistance Coordinator will notify you of any required revisions.



There's still time to submit to allow time for ADEQ to review materials so you may make any necessary revisions before due dates. Please submit as soon as possible.
