

PROPOSED LEAKING UST (LUST) CASE CLEAN UP

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is providing notice in accordance with Arizona Administrative Code R18-12-264.01, that a Revised Corrective Action Plan (CAP) dated July 8, 2016, has been submitted to ADEQ. The CAP contains a proposal to clean up petroleum contamination from an underground storage tank system at the following facility:

The proposed activities include the following cleanup technologies that will be used to obtain the cleanup levels that are protective of public health, welfare and the environment:

In-Situ Chemical Oxidation (ISCO):

Contaminated groundwater will be treated using ISCO by injecting a sodium persulfate based product (PersulfOx®) into the affected well(s) and directly into the formation. ISCO breaks down petroleum related chemicals of concern (COCs) through abiotic chemical oxidation reactions.
