

**NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
HIGHWAY 260 AND MAIN STREET
HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE SITE LISTING**

Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is proposing to list the Highway 260 and Main Street site in Cottonwood, Arizona, on the ADEQ Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site registry pursuant to Arizona Revised Statute §49-287.01.

The Highway 260 and Main Street site is bounded to the north by Mingus Avenue, to the south by Mongini Lane, to the east by the Verde River and and to the west by South 15th Street, South Main Street and Highway 260. The boundaries described are intended to provide the public with the basic information regarding the estimated geographic extent of contamination given current available data. Based on results of further investigations and monitoring, the actual extent of contamination may differ. As such, the geographic boundaries may change as new information becomes available. The contaminants known to be present are tetrachloroethene and trichloroethene.

The site score is 40 out of 120. The site score is based upon a review of available information regarding the presence of hazardous substances at the site. The scoring of a site, its relative score, or its placement on the registry does not necessarily represent a determination that the release of a hazardous substance from the site poses a threat to human health or welfare or the environment.
