NOTICE OF COMBINED PUBLIC MEETING AND POSSIBLE EXECUTIVE SESSION ARIZONA OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Arizona Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (OGCC or Commission) and the general public that the OGCC will hold a meeting open to the public on **July 12, 2017, in Room 3100B**, third floor of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, at 1110 W. Washington St., Phoenix, AZ. **This Regular Session of the OGCC will immediately follow the conclusion of the OGCC Public Hearing, which begins at 1:00 p.m., on the Ranger Development well spacing exception.**

AGENDA:

2. Report by the Oil and Gas Administrator:
 - Amendments to Title 12, Ch. 7 of the Arizona Administrative Code as a result of the GRRC review
 - Amendment to A.A.C. R12-7-107(E) – horizontal drilling [originally proposed in OGCC's March 22, 2012 GRRC Five Year Rule report]
 - Utilization of the Interstate Oil and Gas Compact Commission (IOGCC) for secondary technical oversight of rule revisions
 - Multiple zone completions (A.A.C. R12-7-116) and comingling production (A.A.C. R12-7-137) in wells where 100% of the lease holdings are held by one operator – the Commission shall discuss and vote on whether to grant the Administrator authority, and the limits of that authority, to approve applications involving multiple zone completions or comingling production.
3. Report by the Chairman:
 - Discuss scheduling and content of seminars for the benefit of the OGCC members and staff: 1) Open Meeting Law; and 2) Public Records Law.
4. Call to the public: Members of the public may address the Commission during this Call to the Public. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.01(H), the Commission members may not discuss or take legal action on matters raised during an open call to the public unless the matters are properly noticed for discussion and legal action. Therefore, action taken as a result of public comment will be limited to directing staff to study the matter or scheduling the matter for further discussion and decision on a future agenda.

Members of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission will attend either in person or by telephone. The public may be afforded an opportunity to comment on any item on the agenda; however, at the beginning of the meeting, the Commission may vote to set up a time limit on individual comments. NOTE: The Oil and Gas Conservation Commission may vote to hold an Executive Session, pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3) or (4), which will not be open to the public, for the purpose of obtaining legal advice on any item on the agenda.
