NOTICE OF THE AVAILABILITY OF THE FINAL REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION
(RI) REPORT AND FEASIBILITY STUDY WORK PLAN FOR THE 7TH AVENUE
AND BETHANY HOME ROAD, WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND
(WQARF) REGISTRY SITE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the final Remedial Investigation (RI) report (R18-16-404 (C)(1)(c) and (R18-16-406(J)) and Feasibility Study work plan (R18-16-404(C)(1)(d)) for the 7th Avenue and Bethany Home Road WQARF Registry Site, in Phoenix, AZ. An RI report is prepared to identify the nature, extent, and sources of contaminated soil and waters of the state; identify current and potential impacts to public health, welfare and the environment; identify present and reasonably foreseeable uses of land and waters of the state; and obtain and evaluate any other information necessary for identification and comparison of alternative remedial actions. The final RI report includes the final Remedial Objectives report and responsiveness summaries regarding comments, issues and concerns raised during the community involvement process.

The Feasibility Study work plan is a process to identify a reference remedy and alternative remedies that appear to be capable of achieving remedial objectives and to evaluate them based on the comparison criteria to select a remedy that complies with the remedial action criteria rules under A.R.S. § 49-282.06.

The 7th Avenue and Bethany Home Road WQARF Site consists of a contaminated groundwater plume located in the vicinity of 7th Avenue near Bethany Home Road in Phoenix, Arizona. The plume is bounded to the north by W. Rose Lane, to the south by W. Bethany Home Road, to the east by N. 5th Avenue and to the west by N. 8th Avenue.

A copy of the final RI report and Feasibility Study work plan will be available at the Yucca branch of the City of Phoenix public library. The library is located at 5648 N. 15th Avenue in Phoenix, Arizona, (602) 262-4636. These reports are also available at the ADEQ office in Phoenix.
