NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY CENTRAL AND CAMELBACK WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE FINAL REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION (RI) REPORT

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the final remedial investigation (RI) report for the Central and Camelback Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Phoenix, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-406(J)]. An RI is conducted to document the nature and extent of the contamination and the sources thereof; identify current and potential impacts to public health, welfare, and the environment; identify current and reasonably foreseeable uses of land and waters of the state; and obtain and evaluate any other information necessary for identification and comparison of alternative remedial actions.

The final RI report includes the final remedial objectives report and responsiveness summaries regarding comments, issues and concerns raised during the community involvement process.

The Central and Camelback WQARF site consists of plumes located in Phoenix. The plumes are bounded approximately Georgia Avenue to the north, Mariposa Street to the south, 2nd Street to the east, and 1st Avenue to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are tetrachloroethene and trichloroethene.
