

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY
20th STREET AND FACTOR AVENUE
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE
FEASIBILITY STUDY (FS)**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the feasibility study (FS) for the 20th Street and Factor Avenue Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Yuma, Arizona. An FS is conducted to identify a reference remedy and alternative remedies that appear to be capable of achieving established remedial objectives and to evaluate them based on the comparison criteria to select a remedy.

The 20th Street and Factor Avenue WQARF site consists of a plume located in Yuma. The plume is bounded approximately by 17th Street to the north, 21st Street to the south, Kennedy Lane to the east, and 4th Avenue to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are: Tetrachloroethene (PCE), trichloroethene (TCE), 1, 1-dichloroethene (1, 1-DCE), and cyanide.
