



## Arizona Department of Transportation Dust Control Implementation and Enforcement Report Form

In accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) § 49-411, every year by March 30, Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) is required to submit to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) a report detailing any enforcement, inspection, training or other actions related to contracts or requests for proposals, bids or other construction and service activities overseen by the department in Area A. This includes any requirements incorporated by reference to state law, county ordinance or rule or to a city or town ordinance or rule and required to be contained in bids, requests or contracts or in the administration of other department matters for the previous calendar year.

### Instructions:

**Step 1:** Fill out completely the contact information

**Step 2:** See the first row of the table for an example of how to fill out the table with the following required information:

- **First column:** Read the activity listed for the row as specified under A.R.S. § 49-411(C) pertaining to ADOT.
- **Second column:** Enter a description of employee/contractor inspections, enforcement, training, or other related activities relevant to column 1 of the row
- **Third column:** Enter a description for the scope and frequency of activities related to column 1 for the row.

*Note: Please provide as much detail as possible related to applicable dust control implementation, enforcement, and training activities undertaken by the department during the previous calendar year.*
