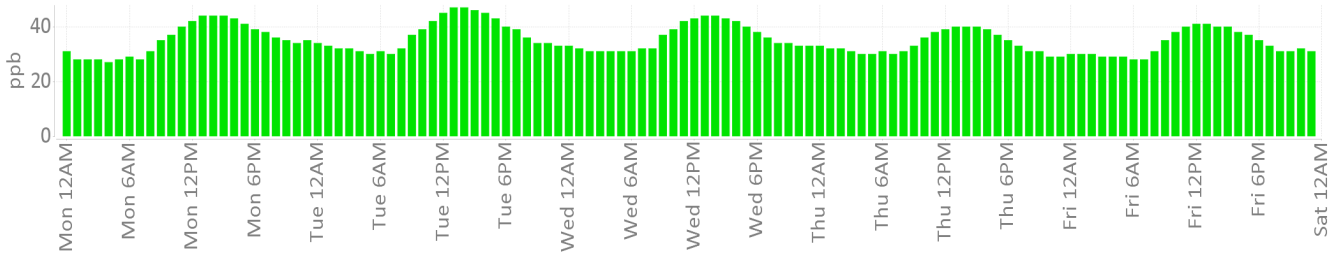

Forecast Discussion

An active period of weather is expected to impact Arizona by the second half of the week, with multiple disturbances migrating eastward off the southern California coast. Moisture increases on Wednesday will bring chances for light precipitation in the northern elevated areas starting on Wednesday, increasing Thursday and peaking on Friday morning. Winds will shift southwesterly by Wednesday at 10-15 mph, turning more westerly as the upper-level disturbances make their way through the region. Cooler air will seep in by the weekend, dropping high temps to below 50°F in Prescott.

In regards to air quality, ozone is forecasted to remain well within the Good AQI category going forward.

Be on the lookout for snowfall chances in your area by the end of the week!
