RE: Arizona Regional Haze State Implementation Plan Revision for the Second Implementation Period

Dear Administrator Guzman:

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) hereby adopts and submits to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) the enclosed state implementation plan (SIP) revision, *State Implementation Plan Revision: Regional Haze Program (2018-2028)*, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Sections 49-104, 49-106, 49-404, 49-458.01, and Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Title 40, Sections 51.102 through 51.104.

The Federal Regional Haze Rule requires states to periodically revise and submit regional haze state implementation plan revisions to address visibility impairment in each mandatory Federal Class I area located within the State and in each mandatory Federal Class I area located outside the State that may be affected by emissions from within the State. The State of Arizona is submitting the enclosed SIP revision which provides the following: calculations of baseline and natural visibility conditions, reasonable progress goals toward natural visibility conditions, a long-term strategy addressing visibility impairment from regional haze, a monitoring strategy, and other implementation plan requirements.

ADEQ requests that EPA take the following actions to approve this revision to the Arizona SIP:

1. Conditionally approve ADEQ's nonpoint reasonable progress determinations for the Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional (ICI) Construction and Paved Roads source categories.
2. Approve all other elements submitted in this SIP revision to meet the requirements of 40 CFR § 51.308, including a source specific SIP revision submitted for approval in Appendix G on behalf of the Pima Department of Environmental Quality.
