



Air Quality Flag Program

Morning Announcements for Flag Program Schools

A morning announcement about the day's air quality flag color will let everyone know the air quality conditions and the actions to take to reduce exposure to air pollution.



"Good morning, students! It's a great day to have fun outside. The air is clean and the flag is GREEN!"



"Good morning, everyone! It's a MODERATE air quality day, so the flag is YELLOW. It's a good day to be active outside! Anyone who is super-sensitive to air pollution should watch for symptoms."



"OK, everyone, it's an ORANGE air quality day... which means the air is approaching unhealthy. It's OK to be active outside for short times, like recess and P.E. class.

"If you have sports practice today, take plenty of breaks and do less-intense drills.

"If you have asthma, follow your asthma action plan and keep your inhaler handy."



"Good morning! Listen up, everyone – it's a RED air quality day! The air is UNHEALTHY! The red flag means we can still go outside today but we need to take it a little easier.

"That means you should take more breaks and don't play as hard. Longer outdoor activities may need to be moved indoors or rescheduled.

"If you have asthma, follow your asthma action plan and keep your inhaler handy."
