

SOLID WASTE FACILITY COMPOSTING NOTIFICATION CHECKLIST

SUBMITTAL OF COMPOSTING NOTIFICATION

This checklist constitutes the outline for the solid waste facility composting notification that is required in accordance with A.R.S. §49-762. This checklist is provided as guidance for creating your notification. It is not required that you complete and submit this form with your notification, however by doing so you will be assisting ADEQ in facilitating its review.

Please note the following:

- · For calculations, state any assumptions made and provide references for values and information used.
- The completeness, organization, and clarity of your submittal will assist ADEQ in facilitating its review. Please number pages, and use good editorial practices such as section headers, and a Table of Contents. Provide technical references as needed.

Use this checklist to ensure that you do not forget to include a notification component. The checklist also includes a cross-reference column in which you may note the location of the requested information in the notification submittal. This will aid ADEQ in facilitating its review, but it is not required.

The notification must receive approval from the Department, as prescribed in A.R.S. §49-762.07, 30 days prior to beginning operation of the facility. Should you have any questions regarding this process, please contact the Solid Waste Unit (SWU) at (602) 771-4136.

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S. § 41-1030):

- (1) ADEQ shall not base a licensing decision, in whole or in part, on a requirement or condition not specifically authorized by statute or rule. General authority in a statute does not authorize a requirement or condition unless a rule is made pursuant to it that specifically authorizes the requirement or condition.
- (2) Prohibited licensing decisions may be challenged in a private civil action. Relief may be awarded to the prevailing party against ADEQ, including reasonable attorney fees, damages, and all fees associated with the license Notification.
- (3) ADEQ employees may not intentionally or knowingly violate the requirement for specific licensing authority. Violation is cause for disciplinary action or dismissal, pursuant to ADEQ's adopted personnel policy. ADEQ employees are still afforded the immunity in A.R.S. §§ 12-821.01 and 12-820.02.
