



Groundwater Protection Permits Rule Clarification Form

Before submitting a permit application, you may request clarification or interpretation of a statute, rule or substantive policy statement related to groundwater protection permits. *Note: This form is now processed through our ADEQ Community Liaisons | [Learn More >](#)*

Once a permit application is submitted, all site-specific inquiries must be made to the county to which the application was submitted. Please note that a request submitted to **ADEQ DOES NOT** prevent the delegated agency from taking formal action. If an applicant is dissatisfied with a delegated agency's formal action, they must utilize the delegated agency's appeal process. Once the delegated agency's appeals process is complete, or if the delegated agency has failed to take formal action within a reasonable amount of time, individuals may contact ADEQ by using this form.
