

Annual Emissions Inventory Rulemaking Stakeholder Values & Project Design Principles

Stakeholder Values	Design Principles
Data requested is actually needed	Ensure that the revised rule applicability mirrors ADEQ's actual data needs.
Clear understanding of the Clean Air Act requirements and focus on necessary changes	Ensure that the revised regulation meets all necessary Clean Air Act requirements.
Concerned that county agencies will still require annual reporting	Maintain open dialogue with county air quality departments as to ADEQ's current rulemaking efforts and support potential county rule revisions in the future.
Consider long term impact of rulemaking on potential future ozone nonattainment areas	Ensure that potential future ozone nonattainment designations are taken into consideration.
Consider cost to produce data	Collect stakeholder feedback on and evaluate the cost of producing the emission inventory questionnaires.
Requirements in Yuma, AZ shouldn't need to be strengthened since the majority of emissions emanate from outside the nonattainment area	Ensure that ADEQ focuses only on those revisions necessary to submit an approvable state implementation plan and retain state primacy in these areas.
