

**NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR
PROPOSED BIOHAZARDOUS MEDICAL WASTE FACILITY PLAN APPROVAL
CLEAN HARBORS ARIZONA, LLC, BIOHAZARDOUS MEDICAL WASTE
STORAGE AND TRANSFER FACILITY
MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has received a *Biohazardous Medical Waste Facility Plan Application* for the Clean Harbors Arizona, LLC biohazardous medical waste storage and transfer facility. The proposed facility is located at 1340 West Lincoln Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007. **This notice commences a 30-day written public comment period from January 31, 2019, through March 2, 2019.**

Biohazardous medical waste collected by Clean Harbors Arizona, LLC trucks at the point of generation will be delivered to the facility for truck-to-truck transfer and storage in a refrigerated storage area. Biohazardous medical waste will be stored for no longer than 90 days in the refrigerated storage area prior to transfer and transport to an approved treatment or disposal facility.

The complete record of this application is available at the ADEQ Phoenix Office at 1110 West Washington Street and may be reviewed from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding State holidays. To arrange an appointment to review this record at ADEQ, contact the ADEQ Records Center at (602) 771-4380.

ADEQ invites all interested parties to submit written comments concerning the proposed facility. All written comments must be signed by the person making the comments and include his/her name and address. **All comments must be submitted to ADEQ postmarked by the close of the public comment period on March 2, 2019.** Submit comments to:

ADEQ will review all written comments. If the Director finds a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, or that a hearing may clarify one or more issues involved in the permit approval, the Director will schedule a public hearing on this matter.
