

**ADEQ Stormwater Construction General Permit Reissuance
Cross-Walk of 2019 CGP Proposed Changes to the Existing 2013 CGP**

Area of Modification	2013 CGP (existing)	2019 CGP (proposed new)
Submission of NOI	Information including name, project type, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revised to meet current myDEQ and U.S. EPA's e-reporting requirements NOIs must be submitted in myDEQ • Added requirement to submit name of receiving waters and latitude/longitude of any outfalls • Existing permittees will have to submit a new NOI and pay initial permit fee to obtain coverage under the reissued permit
Submission of SWPPP, NOT and DMR	Early in the permit, documents were accepted on paper or using the Smart NOI	All documents must be submitted in myDEQ.
ADEQ acceptance of NOI with NO discharges to impaired or OAWs	ADEQ review, typically 1-2 days	myDEQ review is automatic, upon submission of complete and accurate NOI.
Not-attaining Waters	Not specifically addressed	Added to all references of Impaired/OAW as applicable
Erosivity Waiver	Smart-NOI provided calculation methods and requirements for applicability	myDEQ performs the erosivity calculation and if applicable, offers the erosivity waiver to the permittee as part of the NOI process
Requirement to Post Notice of Permit Coverage	Line item in SWPPP section	Moved to Section 2 of the 2019 permit and added specific requirements for contact information
SWPPP submission for discharges to impaired or OAW waters	The SWPPP submission and review fee is required when discharges are within ¼ mile of an impaired water or an OAW	The SWPPP submission and review fee is required when discharges are within ¼ mile of an impaired or not-attaining water for Sediment (SSC) or an OAW
