PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND HEARING

The Air Quality Division of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) welcomes comments on the proposed State Implementation Plan (SIP) Revision for the Miami Sulfur Dioxide (SO₂) Nonattainment Area Demonstrating Compliance with Clean Air Act Sections 110(l) and 193 for the 2010 SO₂ National Ambient Air Quality Standards. The SIP Revision demonstrates that Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) R18-2-C1302 and EPA-approved SIP provisions for the Miami 2010 SO₂ Nonattainment Areas provide a greater level of emission reductions than the SIP rules associated with the 1971 SO₂ NAAQS. The SIP revision will be submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for incorporation in Arizona's State Implementation Plan as required under the Clean Air Act.

Comments will be accepted between November 12, 2019 and December 12, 2019. Comments may be mailed to Lisa Tomczak, Air Quality Division, Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, 1110 W.
