

**DRAFT PERMIT AVAILABLE
HAZARDOUS WASTE STORAGE
CLEAN HARBORS ARIZONA, LLC**

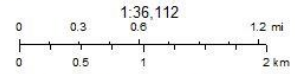
Figure 1 – Site Location

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is providing notice to the public that a draft hazardous waste storage facility permit renewal has been prepared for Clean Harbors Arizona, LLC (Clean Harbors). Clean Harbors is located in Central Phoenix, approximately 1 mile North of I-17 and 1.5 miles South of I-10. The draft permit proposes to allow Clean Harbors to continue to operate a hazardous waste storage facility at 1340 W. Lincoln St., Phoenix, Arizona (see Figure 1 – Site Location Map). This notice commences a 45-day public comment period.

The draft permit authorizes Clean Harbors to continue existing operations as a storage facility for a variety of hazardous and non-hazardous wastes collected from Clean Harbors' customers in the state of Arizona, mainly the metropolitan Phoenix area. The facility includes an office building, a warehouse that provides enclosed container storage, a tank farm with 13 above-ground storage tanks (4 hazardous waste storage tanks and 9 nonhazardous waste storage tanks), a loading dock, a roll off storage area, and 4 work stations. The Clean Harbors facility is a service center where wastes are temporarily stored and sent to off-site recycling centers for purification or to a permitted treatment storage or disposal facility (TSDF) for treatment or destruction. The facility is designed to store 75,000 gallons of hazardous waste in containers and 35,180 gallons of hazardous waste in the hazardous waste storage tank farm. The wastes will be stored and safely managed in approved containers and containment areas. There are no treatment or disposal units on-site, and none are proposed in the draft permit renewal. The hazardous waste permit would be effective for a maximum of 10 years.

All data submitted by Clean Harbors is available as part of an Administrative Record for the draft permit. A copy of the entire Administrative Record is available at the ADEQ Phoenix office from 8:30 am – 4:00 pm, Monday – Friday (excluding state holidays). To arrange an appointment to review this record at ADEQ, contact the ADEQ Records Center at 602-771-4380.

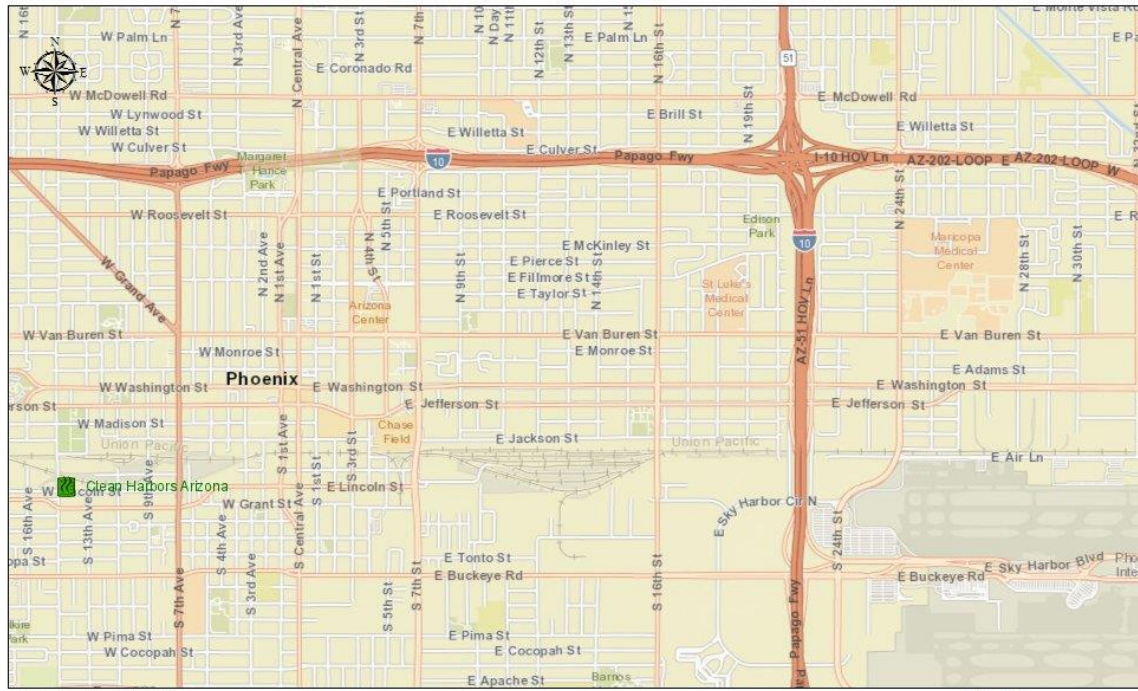
All comments will be considered, and each person who has submitted comments, or makes a specific request, will receive a notice of the final permit decision with procedures for appealing the decision, and a response to all comments received. In addition to submitting public comment, any person may request the ADEQ Director to schedule a public hearing. **Written requests for a public hearing must be submitted to ADEQ by not later than June 3, 2020**, and must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. The Director will hold such a hearing if: 1. he finds, on the basis of requests, a significant degree of public interest in the draft permit, or 2. he finds that the hearing might clarify one or more issues involved in the permit decision, or 3. a formal written notice of opposition to the draft permit is received within the comment period. If a public hearing is to be held, a public notice stating the date, time and place of the hearing will be made at least 30 days before the hearing.
