

PUBLIC NOTICE

YOU HAVE A VOICE IN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL IN ARIZONA

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) proposes to issue Air Quality Control Significant Permit Revision Number 88305 to CEMEX Construction Materials South, LLC to increase the throughput limit for the crushing and screening plant from 5,500 tons per day to 8,700 tons per day, decrease the throughput limit for the concrete batch plant from 5,760 cubic yards per day to 3,000 cubic yards per day, reclassify from a portable source to a stationary source, and install three additional rock conveyor stackers to the wash plant at the CEMEX – Prescott Plant facility located at 13531 East Highway 89A, Prescott Valley, Yavapai County, AZ 86314. The mailing address for the facility is 5555 East Van Buren Street, Suite #155, Phoenix, AZ 85008. The facility is subject to the requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act, Code of Federal Regulations, Arizona Revised Statute 49-426, and the Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 2. The facility emits the following air contaminants: particulate matter, oxides of nitrogen, carbon monoxide, sulfur dioxide, and volatile organic compounds.

This public notice provides information to help you participate in the decision-making process. You have an opportunity to submit written comments on this permit and request that ADEQ hold a public hearing on the permit. The written comment shall include the name, mailing address, signature of commenter and/or their agent or attorney and shall clearly set forth reasons why the permit should or should not be issued. Grounds for comment are limited to whether the permit meets the criteria for issuance spelled out in the state air pollution control laws or rules. The public notice period is in effect from May 12, 2021 to June 10, 2021. The documents are also available at the Town of Prescott Valley, Town Clerk's Office at 7501 East Skoog Boulevard in Prescott Valley, AZ 86314. The draft permit and technical support document may be viewed online at www.azdeq.gov by accessing the Public Notices at the bottom of the webpage and searching for the date of this public notice.

ADEQ will consider all comments received in making a final decision on the proposed permit. Everyone commenting will receive notification of the final decision. People who file comments on the permit will have the right to appeal the final decision as an appealable agency action to the Office of Administrative Hearing (OAH) pursuant to §41.1092.03, and the appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of the final decision. The OAH may sustain, modify, or reverse the final decision.

ADEQ will take reasonable measures to provide access to department services to individuals with limited ability to speak, write or understand English and/or to those with disabilities.
