

PUBLIC NOTICE

YOU HAVE A VOICE IN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL IN ARIZONA

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) proposes to issue Air Quality Control Renewal Permit Number 88788 to Energy Resources (USA) inc. for the construction and operation of an underground uranium mine located at 6.5 miles SE of Tusayan, AZ, Tusayan, Coconino, AZ. The mailing address for the facility is 225 Union Blvd. Suite 600, Lakewood, Colorado. The facility is subject to the requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act, Code of Federal Regulations, Arizona Revised Statute 49-426, and the Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 2. The facility emits the following air contaminants: particulate matter nominally less than 10 micrometers (PM₁₀), particulate matter nominally less than 2.5 micrometers (PM_{2.5}), volatile organic compounds (VOC), nitrogen oxides (NO_x), sulfur dioxide (SO₂), carbon monoxide (CO), hazardous air pollutants (HAPs), and radionuclides.

This public notice provides information to help you participate in the decision-making process. You have an opportunity to submit written comments on the permit and make oral comments on the permit at the public hearing. ADEQ will be holding a virtual public hearing via the GoToWebinar application on July 19, 2021 at 6:00 pm. The written comment shall include the name, mailing address, signature of commenter and/or their agent or attorney and shall clearly set forth reasons why the permit should or should not be issued. Grounds for comment are limited to whether the permit meets the criteria for issuance spelled out in the state air pollution control laws or rules. The public notice period is in effect from June 18, 2021 to July 19, 2021. Comments must be received by July 19, 2021.

The documents are also available at Coconino County, County Clerks Office at 219 E. Cherry Ave. in Flagstaff, AZ 86001. The draft permit and technical support document may be viewed online at www.azdeq.gov by accessing the Public Notices at the bottom of the webpage and searching for the date of this public notice.

ADEQ will consider all comments received in making a final decision on the proposed permit. Everyone commenting will receive notification of the final decision. People who file comments on the permit will have the right to appeal the final decision as an appealable agency action to the Office of Administrative Hearing (OAH) pursuant to §41.1092.03, and the appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of the final decision. The OAH may sustain, modify, or reverse the final decision.

ADEQ will take reasonable measures to provide access to department services to individuals with limited ability to speak, write or understand English and/or to those with disabilities. Requests for language translation, ASL interpretation, CART captioning services or disability accommodations must be made at least 48 hours in advance
