

**PROPOSED ARIZONA POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (AZPDES)
PRETREATMENT PROGRAM APPROVAL**

Pursuant to the Clean Water Act and in accordance with Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) R18-9-A907, the Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is issuing a notice of proposed action. ADEQ has received a request from the following Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW) for approval of their Pretreatment Program.

The City of Buckeye is a POTW that receives domestic wastewater from residential, commercial, and industrial sources. A determination by the ADEQ to approve this request would allow the POTW to regulate the discharge of pollutants into the treatment works from Industrial Users by carrying out inspection and monitoring to determine compliance with applicable Pretreatment Standards.

Persons may submit comments or request a public hearing on the proposed action in writing, to Mindi Cross, Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, Water Quality Division, 1110 W. Washington St., Phoenix, Arizona 85007, or electronically to cross.mindi@adeq.gov. All written comments received by ADEQ by the close of business on the date 30 days after publication of this notice will be considered in the final permit decision. A public hearing request must be in writing and must include the reasons for such request. If there is a significant degree of public interest, the Director will hold a hearing in accordance with A.A.C. R18-9-A908(B).

ADEQ will take reasonable measures to provide access to department services to individuals with limited ability to speak, write or understand English and/or to those with disabilities.
