

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD  
LINE 90 – OLD KINGMAN PUMP STATION  
VOLUNTARY REMEDIATION PROGRAM (VRP) SITE  
HUMAN HEALTH RISK ASSESSMENT**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) has received a Human Health Risk Assessment (HHRA) for the Line 90 – Old Kingman Pump Station (VRP Site Code 503929-00) VRP site (the Site). The Site consists of two adjacent parcels (accessor parcel numbers 322-23-026 and 322-23-024) located on E. Hualapai Mountain Road in Kingman, Arizona. The HHRA was submitted in accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes §§ 49-175 and 49-176.

The HHRA uses proven methodologies and parameters commonly accepted by the scientific community to evaluate health risks associated with potential exposure to contaminants of concern detected in soil at the Site. Contaminants of concern at the Site are polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons.
