

NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION TO ISSUE A SIGNIFICANT AMENDMENT TO AN INDIVIDUAL AQUIFER PROTECTION PERMIT

Pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 9, Article 1, the Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality intends to issue a significant amendment to an Individual Aquifer Protection Permit (APP) for the following applicant:

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Permittee: Hope Water Arizona South, Inc.

Facility: Clear Springs Wastewater Treatment Plant

Permit No.: 100824 **LTF:** 87662

The facility is located at Allen Street west of US Highway 191, Sunsites in Cochise County, Arizona.

Facility Description

The permittee is authorized to operate the Clear Springs Wastewater Treatment Plant with a maximum average monthly flow of 69,000 gallons per day. The purpose of this amendment is to propose a new POW well to replace the existing well and updated the closure cost estimate and financial assurance mechanism.

You may request a public hearing on the proposed action by email or mail. A public hearing request must be in writing and must include the reasons for such request. If there is a significant degree of public interest, the Director will hold a hearing.
