## NOTICE OF THE PRELIMINARY DECISION TO ISSUE A SIGNIFICANT AMENDMENT TO AN INDIVIDUAL AQUIFER PROTECTION PERMIT

Pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 9, Article 1, the Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality intends to issue a significant amendment to an Aquifer Protection Permit (APP) to the following applicant:

Facility Name: Mineral Park Mine

Individual Aquifer Protection Permit No. 100517, LTF No. 93500

**Permittee:** Origin Mining Company, LLC

The facility is located 16 miles north of Kingman, Arizona, in Mohave County, over groundwater of the Hualapai Groundwater Basin, in Township 23N, Range 17W, Section 19, and Range 18W Sections 24, 25, 26, 35, and 36, of the Gila and Salt River Baseline and Meridian.
