

NOTICE OF THE PRELIMINARY DECISION TO ISSUE AN OTHER AMENDMENT TO AN INDIVIDUAL AQUIFER PROTECTION PROGRAM PERMIT

Details

Energy Fuels Resources, Inc. and ADEQ have entered into a Changed Application Agreement for an 'other' amendment to the facility's Aquifer Protection Program (APP) Permit to revise the Alert Level (AL) and Aquifer Quality Limit (AQL) after monitoring indicated a change in arsenic concentrations in groundwater that were not due to the addition of pollutants to the aquifer from the facility's discharge. The facility is located in Coconino County, approximately six miles south-southeast of Tusayan, Arizona.

The permit amendment has also been noticed through the Permits in Process report online at https://azdeq.gov/PIP_Report since receipt of the original application in November, 2025.
