Details

The Arizona Department of Corrections has applied for a new Individual APP Reclaimed Water Permit to reinstate the use of treated wastewater effluent (Class B+) and reverse osmosis (RO) reject water for irrigation use at five grass fields on the property. Irrigation with blended wastewater is to sustain grass grown in the fields at the facility and is not necessary to meet the disposal capacity for the facility.

You may request a public hearing on the proposed action by email or mail. A public hearing request must be in writing and must include the reasons for such request. If there is a significant degree of public interest, the Director will hold a hearing.²
