YOU HAVE A VOICE IN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL IN ARIZONA

ADEQ proposes to issue Air Quality Control Permit Number 106233 to Aluminum Dynamics, Inc. for the installation and operation of a recycled aluminum ingot casting center to be located Benson, Arizona 85602 near the intersection of State Route 80 and E. 7th St. The mailing address for the facility is 7575 West Jefferson Blvd, Fort Wayne IN, 46804. The facility is subject to the requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act, Code of Federal Regulations, Arizona Revised Statute 49-426, and the Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 2. The facility will emit the following air contaminants: coarse particulate matter with diameters 10 micrometers or less (PM₁₀), fine particulate matter with diameters 2.5 micrometers or less (PM_{2.5}), volatile organic compounds (VOCs), nitrogen oxides (NO_x), sulfur dioxide (SO₂), carbon monoxide (CO), and hazardous air pollutants (HAPs).

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) conducted a public comment period for the proposed issuance of Air Quality Control Permit Number 106233 to Aluminum Dynamics, Inc. from July 16, 2025 to August 21, 2025 and hosted a formal public hearing on August 21, 2025. ADEQ has made the decision to extend the public comment period until Tuesday, September 16, 2025.

This public notice provides information to help you participate in the decision-making process. You have an opportunity to submit written comments about this permit. To submit written comments, include your name, mailing address, signature (and/or your agent or attorney signature) and clearly explain why the permit should or should not be issued. Grounds for comment are limited to whether the permit meets the criteria for issuance spelled out in the state air pollution control laws or rules. The public notice period is extended to September 16, 2025. Comments may be submitted in writing to: [Jeff Christensen](mailto:Jeff.Christensen@azdeq.gov), Air Permits Unit, ADEQ, 1110 W. The draft permit and related documentation are available for review online at azdeq.gov/publicnotices by searching for the date of this public notice, or in person at the ADEQ Records Center by scheduling an appointment at least 48 hours in advance. The documents are also available at the Benson City Clerk's Office located at 101 E. 6th Street, Benson AZ, 85602.

ADEQ will consider all comments received in making a final decision on the proposed permit. Everyone commenting will receive notification of the final decision. People who file comments on the permit will have the right to appeal the final decision as an appealable agency action to the Office of Administrative Hearing (OAH) pursuant to §41.1092.03, and the appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of the final decision. The OAH may sustain, modify, or reverse the final decision.

This permit is subject to review by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) pursuant to 40 CFR 70.8 and Arizona Administrative Code R18-2-307. If EPA does not object to the issuance of this permit, you may petition to EPA within sixty (60) days after the expiration of EPA's forty-five (45)-day review period. A petition shall be based only on objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the public comment period, unless the petitioner demonstrates that it was impracticable to raise such objections within such period, or unless the grounds for such objection arose after such period. Please refer to epa.gov/title-v-operating-permits/title-v-petitions for additional information. Any person who petitions to EPA pursuant to 40 CFR 70.8(d) shall notify ADEQ by certified mail as soon as possible, but in no case more than 10 days following such petition. The

notification shall include the grounds for objection and whether such objections were raised during the public comment period.

ADEQ will take reasonable measures to provide access to department services to individuals with limited ability to speak, write or understand English and/or to those with disabilities. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Sign shall be 3-feet wide by 4-feet high.
2. Bottom of sign shall be 18 inches above the ground.
3. Sign shall be supported by two anchor posts.
4. Sign shall be posted on the affected property in such a manner as to be legible from the public right-of-way.
5. Sign shall be black letters on a white background.
6. Sign shall be made of 1/4-inch plywood.
