

**30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON
PROPOSED STATE OF ARIZONA ANNUAL AIR MONITORING NETWORK PLAN
FOR THE YEAR 2024**

Pursuant to 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §58.10 Arizona Department of Environmental Quality will make its annual monitoring network plan available for public inspection for 30 days prior to submission to the United States Environmental Protection Agency. The plan presents the current status and future changes to the ambient monitoring network. The document will be posted on the ADEQ Web site for thirty days beginning May 22, 2024 and ending June 21, 2024. During this time period the document will also be available for review at the following locations:
