The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division, has completed its review of the referenced permit application.

I am prepared to recommend that your air quality control permit be issued with conditions necessary to meet all rules and regulations applicable to this source related to air pollution control. A draft of the permit with appropriate conditions is enclosed for your review.

In accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes §49-426.D, a public notice will be issued in *The Daily Courier* on April 12, 2022 and April 19, 2022, and *Prescott Valley Tribune* on April 13, 2022 and April 20, 2022, and will give instructions for making comments and an opportunity to request a public hearing on the permit. A copy of this public notice is also enclosed.

You will need to post a copy of this public notice adjacent to the nearest public roadway on the property where your facility is located. This notice posting should conform to the attached public notice posting requirements. The notice should be posted from the date of first publication to May 12, 2022.

## PUBLIC NOTICE

### YOU HAVE A VOICE IN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL IN ARIZONA

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) proposes to issue Air Quality Control New Permit No. 92038 to Henrietta Mine, LLC for crushing and screening operations at Henrietta Mine located at 5850 Henrietta Mine Road, Mayer, Yavapai, AZ 86333. The mailing address for the facility is 3417 S. Valerie Drive, Chandler, AZ 85286. The facility is subject to the requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act, Code of Federal Regulations, Arizona Revised Statute 49-426, and the Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 2. The facility emits the following air contaminants: particulate matter with an aerodynamic diameter equal to or less than 2.5 micrometers (PM<sub>2.5</sub>), particulate matter with an aerodynamic diameter equal to or less than 10 micrometers (PM<sub>10</sub>), nitrogen oxides (NO<sub>x</sub>), sulfur dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>), carbon monoxide (CO), volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and hazardous air pollutants (HAPs).

This public notice provides information to help you participate in the decision-making process. You have an opportunity to submit written comments about this permit and request that ADEQ hold a public hearing about the permit. To submit written comments, include your name, mailing address, signature (and/or your agent's or attorney's signature) and clearly explain why the permit should or should not be issued. Grounds for comment are limited to whether the permit meets the criteria for issuance spelled out in the state air pollution control laws or rules. The public notice period is in effect from April 12, 2022 to May 12, 2022. ADEQ will consider all comments received in making a final decision on the proposed permit. Everyone commenting will receive notification of the final decision. People who file comments on the permit will have the right to appeal the final decision as an appealable agency action to the Office of Administrative Hearing (OAH) pursuant to §41.1092.03, and the appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of the final decision. The OAH may sustain, modify, or reverse the final decision.

ADEQ will take reasonable measures to provide access to department services to individuals with limited ability to speak, write or understand English and/or to those with disabilities. ### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Sign shall be 3-feet wide by 4-feet high.
2. Bottom of sign shall be 18 inches above the ground.
3. Sign shall be supported by two anchor posts.
4. Sign shall be posted on the affected property in such a manner as to be legible from the public right of way.
5. Sign shall be black letters on a white background.
6. Sign shall be made of 1/4-inch plywood.
