## PROPOSED ARIZONA POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (AZPDES) RENEWAL PERMIT

Pursuant to the Clean Water Act and in accordance with Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) R18-9-A907, the Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) proposes to issue an Arizona Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (AZPDES) Permit to discharge pollutants to Waters of the United States to the following applicant, subject to certain effluent limitations and special conditions:

City of Yuma applied for a renewal AZPDES permit for the proposed discharge of up to 12 million gallons per day (mgd) of treated domestic wastewater from the Figueroa Avenue WPCF to the Colorado River in the Lower Gila River Basin in Township 16 S, Range 22 E, Section 28, in Yuma County, Arizona. The Figueroa Avenue WPCF is a publicly owned treatment works that receives domestic wastewater from residential, commercial, and industrial sources in Yuma. Digested and thickened sludge is hauled from the WPCF by an independent contractor (AG Tech, LLC) and utilized for agricultural land application.

Persons may submit comments or request a public hearing on the proposed action in writing, to Julia Rowe, Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, Water Quality Division, 400 W. Congress St., Tucson, Arizona 85701, or electronically to rowe.julia@azdeq.gov. All written comments received by ADEQ by the close of business on the date 30 days after publication of this notice will be considered in the final permit decision. A public hearing request must be in writing and must include the reasons for such request. If there is a significant degree of public interest, the Director will hold a hearing in accordance with A.A.C. R18-9-A908(B).

ADEQ will take reasonable measures to provide access to department services to individuals with limited ability to speak, write or understand English and/or to those with disabilities.
