

PROPOSED ARIZONA POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (AZPDES)
RENEWAL PERMIT

Pursuant to the Clean Water Act and in accordance with Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) R18-9-A907, the Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) proposes to issue an Arizona Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (AZPDES) Permit to discharge pollutants to Waters of the United States to the following applicant, subject to certain effluent limitations and special conditions:

Frito-Lay, Inc. applied for a renewal AZPDES permit for the proposed discharge of up to 0.69 million gallons per day (mgd) of treated process wastewater generated from the manufacturing of salty snack foods from the Frito-Lay – Casa Grande Facility to an unnamed wash that is tributary to the North Branch of the Santa Cruz, which is tributary to the Santa Cruz Wash in the Santa Cruz River Basin in Township 6 S, Range 5 E, Section 14, in Pinal County, Arizona. The Frito-Lay – Casa Grande is an industrial Salty Snack Food Manufacturing Plant that treats wastewater. Discharges from the facility will only occur when the Low-Pressure Reverse Osmosis (LPRO) system is offline, during the replacement of Granular Activated Carbon (GAC), while performing preventative maintenance on the LPRO system, when production exceeds demand, or during emergency situations.

Persons may submit comments or request a public hearing on the proposed action in writing, to Kasanneni Swathi, Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, Water Quality Division, 1110 W. Washington St., Phoenix, Arizona 85007, or electronically to kasanneni.swathi@azdeq.gov. All written comments received by ADEQ by the close of business on the date 30 days after publication of this notice will be considered in the final permit decision. A public hearing request must be in writing and must include the reasons for such request. If there is a significant degree of public interest, the Director will hold a hearing in accordance with A.A.C. R18-9-A908(B).

ADEQ will take reasonable measures to provide access to department services to individuals with limited ability to speak, write or understand English and/or to those with disabilities.
