

## **Proposed Arizona Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (AZPDES) Permit Modification**

Pursuant to the Clean Water Act and in accordance with Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) R18-9-A907, the Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) proposes to modify an AZPDES Permit for discharges of stormwater to waters of the U.S. to the following applicant:

ADEQ proposes to modify the City's permit to incorporate 24-hour emergency non-compliance reporting for spills which may be harmful to human health and the environment.
