The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has reviewed the requirements of 40 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) Part 60, Subpart FFFF, included in “Emission Guidelines and Compliance Times for Other Solid Waste Incineration Units”, promulgated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) final rule, 90 FR 27955 (June 30, 2025).

In accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 60.2982, ADEQ is submitting this negative declaration letter to the EPA. ADEQ asserts that the State of Arizona, excluding all Tribal Lands, contains no OSWI units subject to the requirements of 40 C.F.R. Part 60, Subpart FFFF. This is true for all state and county planning jurisdictions in Arizona, including Maricopa County, Pima County, and Pinal County.
