**PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND HEARING**

The Air Quality Division of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) welcomes comments on the proposed Arizona Dust Mitigation Plan Review and Evaluation Final Report and Updated Mitigation Plan. The review and update demonstrate that the State of Arizona has the necessary programs to reduce particulate matter (PM<sub>10</sub>) emissions and limit public exposure during high-wind dust events in the Phoenix, Rillito, West Pinal, and Yuma PM<sub>10</sub> nonattainment areas. The review and update will be submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as required by [40 CFR § 51.930\(b\)\(2\)\(iii\)](#).

Comments will be accepted between July 28, 2022 and August 31, 2022. Comments may be mailed or emailed to Laura Mirtich, Air Quality Division, Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, 1110 W.
