Re: Arizona's Safe Drinking Water Act Primacy Revision Applications

The State of Arizona is pleased to submit to you primacy revision applications for the Public Water System Supervision (PWSS) program administered by the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) in accordance with 40 CFR §142.12. The State of Arizona received initial primary enforcement approval from EPA in 1978 (43 FR 38083).

Enclosed are the following for EPA's review and approval pursuant to 40 CFR §142.12 and §142.13:

- An Attorney General's Statement dated March 9, 2021 that certifies that the laws and regulations adopted by Arizona were duly adopted and are enforceable. The Statement also certifies Arizona's administrative penalty and environmental audit privilege laws, and provides a clear statement of delegated authority.
- Primacy revision crosswalks for Filter Backwash Recycling, Groundwater and Radionuclides Rules, which include copies of relevant laws in the Arizona Revised Statutes, rules in the Arizona Administrative Code and other documents ADEQ uses to fulfill the rule requirements. (Attachment 1).
