

**DRAFT HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT FOR STORAGE AND TREATMENT IN TANKS AND CONTAINERS
TRIUMVIRATE ENVIRONMENTAL (ARIZONA) INC.
73 SOUTH COMMERCE DRIVE, CASA GRANDE, PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA, 85193**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has prepared a draft Storage and Treatment Hazardous Waste Permit (Draft Permit) for Triumvirate Environmental (Arizona) Inc (TEI). The Draft Permit would allow TEI to perform hazardous waste management activities located at 73 S Commerce Dr, Casa Grande, AZ, 85193. This notice announces the 45-day public comment period for the Draft Permit beginning April 7, 2024, and ending May 22, 2024.

The draft permit allows TEI to operate a hazardous waste management facility. Hazardous waste management activities include treatment, storage, consolidation and bulking of hazardous waste for transportation, and bulking of organic liquids. The facility includes administrative offices in the southeast quadrant of the facility, non-hazardous waste processing operations conducted in the northeast quadrant, and hazardous treatment and storage operations conducted in the northwest quadrant. The facility will encompass approximately 25 acres of land in the Central Arizona Commerce Park which is zoned I-2 for heavy industrial use within the City of Casa Grande.

All data submitted by TEI for the Draft Permit is available as part of the administrative record. The administrative record also includes the permit application, RCRA Facility Assessment Report, Fact Sheet, and communications. A copy of the Draft Permit, administrative record, and Fact Sheet can be viewed by searching the listing at azdeq.gov/publicnotices by the public notice start date. These documents can also be viewed at the ADEQ Phoenix office from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (excluding state holidays). In addition to submitting public comments, any person may request the ADEQ Director to schedule a public hearing. **Written requests for a public hearing must be submitted to ADEQ by no later than May 22, 2024**, and must state the nature of the proposed issues to raise in the hearing. The Director will hold such a hearing if: 1) they find, on the basis of requests, a significant degree of public interest in the Draft Permit, or 2) they find that the hearing might clarify any issues involved in the permit decision, or 3) a formal written notice of opposition to the Draft Permit is received within the comment period.
