Pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 9, Article 1, the Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality intends to issue a significant amendment to an Aquifer Protection Permit (APP) to the following applicant(s):

The public comment period is in effect from October 27, 2017, to December 5, 2017. A public hearing will be held at Apache County Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, First Floor, 75 West Cleveland Street, St. Johns, Arizona 85936, on Tuesday November 28, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. The purpose of the hearing is to allow the public to make comments for the record. ADEQ will respond in writing to all comments submitted during the public comment period. ADEQ staff will be available from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m. to answer questions about the permit.
