

PUBLIC NOTICE

YOU HAVE A VOICE IN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL IN ARIZONA

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has reached a preliminary determination and is proposing to issue the following Air Quality General Permits:

- Renewal General Permit for Crushing and Screening Plants
- Renewal General Permit Hot Mix Asphalt Plants
- Reopening of General Permit for Air Curtain Incinerators

General Permits are a type of permit that applies to a class of sources; consequently, these will affect multiple sources throughout the state. These permits contain requirements from the Federal Clean Air Act, Arizona Revised Statute 49-426, the Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 2 and applicable regulations from Maricopa, Pima, and Pinal county codes. The proposed renewal general permits will limit emissions of the following types of air contaminants: particulate matter, particulate matter less than 10 microns, nitrogen oxides, carbon monoxide, sulfur dioxide and volatile organic compounds.

You have an opportunity to submit written comments on the permit revision and make oral comments on the permit revision at the public hearing. ADEQ will be holding public hearings for these three General Permits on March 31, 2017, at ADEQ conference room 3175 A & B, 1110 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007 as per the following schedule:

- 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm: for Crushing and Screening Plants;
- 2:00 pm to 3:00 pm for the Hot Mix Asphalt Plants; and
- 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm for Air Curtain Incinerators

The written comment shall include the name, mailing address, signature of commenter and/or their agent or attorney and shall clearly set forth reasons why the permit should or should not be issued. Grounds for comment are limited to whether the permits meet the criteria for issuance spelled out in the state air pollution control laws or rules.

The draft permits and related documentation are available for review Monday through Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., at the [ADEQ Records Center](#), at 1110 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona. The documents are also available at ADEQ-Southern Regional Office, 400 West Congress, Suite 433, Tucson, AZ 85701. The draft permits and technical support documents may be viewed online at www.azdeq.gov by accessing the notice on the Events and Notices Calendar for the date of this public notice. The public notice period is in effect from March 1, 2017 to March 31, 2017. Comments may be submitted in writing to:
