Pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 9, Article 1, the Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality intends to issue a significant amendment to an Aquifer Protection Permit (APP) to the following applicant(s):

The facility is located near the Town of Dripping Springs, Cochise County Arizona, over groundwater of the Willcox Groundwater Basin, within Township 15 South, Range 22 East, and all or parts of Sections 22 to 27, 35 and 36, of the Gila and Salt River Base Line and Meridian
