

PUBLIC NOTICE

YOU HAVE A VOICE IN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL IN ARIZONA

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) proposes to issue Air Quality Control Renewal Permit No. 67001 to Rosemont Copper Company for the construction and operation of an open pit copper mine facility located at 21900 S. Sonoita Highway, Vail, Pima County, Arizona 85641. The mailing address for the facility is 5255 East Williams Circle, Suite 1065, Tucson, Arizona 85711. The facility is subject to the requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act, Code of Federal Regulations, Arizona Revised Statute 49-426, and the Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 2. The facility emits the following air contaminants: particulate matter, nitrogen oxides, carbon monoxide, sulfur dioxide, volatile organic compounds, sulfuric acid, greenhouse gases and hazardous air pollutants.

You have an opportunity to submit written comments on the permit renewal and make oral comments on the permit renewal at the public hearing. ADEQ will be holding a public hearing on Tuesday, February 20, 2018, at 6:00 pm at the Corona Foothills Middle School, 16705 South Houghton Road, Corona De Tucson, AZ 85641. The written comment shall include the name, mailing address, signature of commenter and/or their agent or attorney and shall clearly set forth reasons why the permit should or should not be issued. Grounds for comment are limited to whether the permit renewal meets the criteria for issuance spelled out in the state air pollution control laws or rules.

The draft permit renewal and related documentation are available for review Monday through Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., at the [ADEQ Records Center](#), at 1110 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona. Please call (602) 771-4380 or email recordscenter@azdeq.gov 48 hours in advance to schedule an appointment to review the file. The documents are also available at Pima County Clerk's Office at 130 West Congress in Tucson, AZ 85701. The draft permit and technical support document may be viewed online at www.azdeq.gov by accessing the notice on the Events and Notices Calendar for the date of this public notice. The public notice period is in effect from January 19, 2018 to February 20, 2018. Persons wishing to submit written comments can also do so at the public hearing. Comments must be received by February 20, 2018.

ADEQ will consider all comments received in making a final decision on the proposed permit renewal. Everyone commenting will receive notification of the final decision. People who file comments on the permit renewal will have the right to appeal the final decision as an appealable agency action to the Office of Administrative Hearing (OAH) pursuant to §41.1092.03, and the appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of the final decision. The OAH may sustain, modify, or reverse the final decision.

ADEQ will take reasonable measures to provide access to department services to individuals with limited ability to speak, write, or understand English and/or to those with disabilities.
