

**DRAFT PERMIT FOR
HAZARDOUS WASTE STORAGE FACILITY
SAFETY-KLEEN SYSTEMS, INC.
6625 WEST FRYE ROAD, CHANDLER, AZ**




Figure 1 - Site Location

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) hereby gives notice of its intent to renew the hazardous waste permit held by Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. (Safety-Kleen) Chandler facility. The permit allows Safety-Kleen to continue to operate a hazardous waste storage facility at 6625 West Frye Road, Chandler, Arizona, 85226 (see Figure 1 – Site Location Map). The facility is currently operating pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code (AAC) Title 18, Chapter 8 (40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 264). This notice commences a 45-day public comment period from **October 23, 2016 through December 06, 2016**.

The permit allows Safety-Kleen to continue to operate a commercial storage facility for spent organic solvents, aqueous-based cleaners, paint wastes, photo imaging wastes and dry cleaning wastes collected from Safety-Kleen's customers in the state of Arizona, mainly the metropolitan Phoenix area. The facility includes an office building, a warehouse that provides enclosed container storage, a tank farm with three aboveground storage tanks, and a loading dock with a solvent return-and-fill station and two drum washer units. The Safety-Kleen Chandler facility is a "service center" where wastes are temporarily stored and sent to offsite recycling centers for purification or to a permitted treatment, storage or disposal facility (TSDF) for treatment or destruction. The purified solvents are then returned to the Safety-Kleen Chandler facility as reclaimed clean product. The facility is designed to store 17,160 gallons of hazardous waste in containers and 11,400 gallons in the hazardous waste storage tank. The wastes will be stored and safely managed in approved containers and containment areas. There are no treatment or disposal units onsite, and none are proposed in the draft permit renewal.

All data submitted by Safety-Kleen is available as part of an Administrative Record for the draft permit. A copy of the draft permit can be viewed at the Chandler Public Library, Sunset Branch, 4930 W. Ray Rd, Chandler, AZ, Monday – Thursday from 10am – 8pm; Friday – Saturday from 10am – 6pm; and Sunday from 1 pm to 5 pm. A copy of the entire administrative record is available at the ADEQ Phoenix office from 8:30 am – 4:30 pm, Monday – Friday (excluding state holidays). In addition to submitting public comment, any person may request the ADEQ Director to schedule a public hearing. Written requests for a public hearing must be submitted to ADEQ by **not later than December 06, 2016**, and must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. The Director will hold such a hearing if: 1) he finds, on the basis of requests, a significant degree of public interest in the draft permit, or 2) he finds that the hearing might clarify one or more issues involved in the permit decision, or 3) a formal written notice of opposition to the draft permit is received within the comment period.
