

## **ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY** **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND HEARING**

Pursuant to Section 107(d)(1)(B) of the Clean Air Act (CAA), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) designated an area in southwest Yuma County as a “marginal” nonattainment area for the 2015 8-hour Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) in 2018. EPA based its designation on recorded violations of the standard at an ambient monitoring site within the County.

Under the authority granted by the Governor and the State of Arizona, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is responsible for the preparation and submittal of this State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision.

The ADEQ Air Quality Division welcomes comments on this proposed Yuma Ozone Marginal SIP Revision.
