## NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY

## COOPER ROAD AND COMMERCE AVENUE WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND SITE RECORD OF DECISION (ROD)

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has issued a Record of Decision (ROD), which is deemed a final administrative decision as pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes §49-287.04 for the Cooper Road and Commerce Avenue Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Gilbert, Arizona. The ROD contains a description of the remedy, a responsiveness summary regarding all comments received on the proposed remedial action plan, a time for completing the remedy, and a total estimated cost.

The Cooper Road and Commerce Avenue WQARF site consists of a groundwater contaminant plume located in Gilbert, AZ. The plume is bounded approximately by West Houston Avenue to the north, West Cullumber Avenue to the south, North Golden Key Drive to the east, and North El Dorado Drive to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are tetrachloroethene and trichloroethene.
