

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY
SFPP SILVERCROFT WASH RELEASE SITE
VOLUNTARY REMEDIATION PROGRAM SITE
FEASIBILITY STUDY (FS) WORK PLAN**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has approved the feasibility study (FS) work plan to implement the FS for the SFPP Silvercroft Wash Release Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) site in Tucson, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-404(C)(1)(d)]. An FS is conducted to identify a reference remedy and alternative remedies that appear to be capable of achieving established remedial objectives and to evaluate them based on the comparison criteria to select a remedy. The FS is anticipated to begin April 2018.

The SFPP Silvercroft Wash Release VRP site consists of a plume located west of the I-10 Freeway, north of Grant Road, along the Silvercroft Wash in Tucson. The plume is bounded approximately by the extension of Goret Road to the north, Silverbell Tree Drive to the south, Silver Island Way to the east, and Mountain Creek Way to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and total xylenes (BTEX) and methyl tertiary-butyl ether (MTBE).
