ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND HEARING

The Air Quality Division of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) welcomes comments on the proposed 2025 Arizona Regional Haze Progress Report. The progress report provides information on visibility trends at important Arizona natural areas that are protected under the Clean Air Act, known as Class I areas. The report will be submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to comply with the periodic progress report requirements under the regional haze rule of the Clean Air Act.

Comments will be accepted between November 5, 2024 and December 5, 2024.
