

**NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR
TYPE IV VERTICAL EXPANSION
MOHAVE VALLEY LANDFILL
MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has received a Type IV facility plan modification for the Mohave Valley Landfill from Mohave County. The Mohave Valley Landfill is located at 3999 El Rodeo Road, Fort Mohave, Arizona 86426. **This notice commences a 30-day written public comment period from June 29, 2026 to July 29, 2026.**

The Mohave Valley Landfill has been in operation since the 1980s. The landfill property boundary encompasses approximately 159.9 acres of land with the waste disposal area utilizing approximately 110.8 of those acres. The proposed modifications to the landfill include increasing the fill height and modifying the bottom grading of the landfill. The revised fill and excavation grades will increase the capacity of the landfill by approximately 9.5 million cubic yards from the current 14,950,100 cubic yards to a total airspace volume of approximately 24,532,400 cubic.

The complete record of this application is available at the ADEQ Phoenix Office at 1110 West Washington Street and may be reviewed from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding State holidays. ADEQ invites all interested parties to submit written comments concerning the proposed facility.
