

## **PROPOSED LEAKING UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK (LEAKING UST) RELEASE CASE CLOSURE**

### **Details**

Arizona regulations<sup>1</sup> allow case closure at leaking UST sites with groundwater contamination at levels above the Arizona Aquifer Water Quality Standards (AWQS) if it can be demonstrated that there is no exposure risk to public health and any remaining contamination is attenuating. We evaluated site specific conditions and analytical data and determined that the case meets the regulatory requirements for closure.
