REQUEST FOR A NO FURTHER ACTION DETERMINATION**

KKSZ Investments, LLC has submitted a request for a No Further Action (NFA) determination to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) for the 6230 N 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue VRP site. The NFA requests closure for soil and was submitted in accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes § 49-181.

The 6230 N. 43<sup>rd</sup> Ave VRP site consists of a former dry-cleaning facility located in Glendale, Arizona. The primary contaminant of concern at the site is Tetrachloroethene (PCE).
