

NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ADAIR MEMORIAL PARK ARCHERY RANGE VOLUNTARY REMEDIATION PROGRAM SITE REQUEST FOR NO FURTHER ACTION DETERMINATION

Yuma County Department of Public Works has submitted a request for a No Further Action (NFA) determination to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) for the Adair Memorial Park Archery Range VRP site. The NFA requests closure for soil and was submitted in accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes § 49-181.

The Adair Memorial Park Archery Range VRP site covers approximately 24 acres on property owned by Yuma County, located in Yuma, Arizona. The site was once contained a silver ore processing facility. Contaminants of concern at the site consist of lead residues in the soil that was in the processed ore tailings from the silver ore processing that were discarded on site.
