NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND 30- DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD I-10 AVRA VALLEY MINING & DEVELOPMENT VOLUNTARY REMEDIATION PROGRAM (VRP) SITE WORK PLAN FOR REMEDIATION

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has received a work plan for the I-10 Avra Valley Mining & Development VRP site. The work plan proposes discrete soil sampling and an incremental sampling approach for soil characterization and soil remediation by excavation, where necessary. The work plan was submitted in accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) § 49-175 and § 176.

The I-10 Avra Valley Mining & Development site consists of a former copper ore railcar loading and transfer facility located at an address known as 7755 and 7851 West Avra Valley Road in Marana, Arizona. Contaminants of concern at the site are arsenic, cadmium, copper and lead.
